

**RESOLUTION 2023-02**

**SUBJECT: Amendments to the Brownsville to Los Fresnos Connect  
Phase I & II (CSJ 0921-06-322 & 0921-06-324) project**

**WHEREAS**, the Brownsville Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMPO) received an apportionment of federal TASA funds for FY2019-2020 and awarded \$1,024,000 of these funds to the City of Brownsville for construction of the Brownsville to Los Fresnos Connect Phase I & II (CSJ 0921-06-322 & 0921-06-324) project; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2019 the BMPO merged with the Hidalgo County Metropolitan Planning Organization (HCMPO) and Harlingen-San Benito Metropolitan Planning Organization (HSBMPO) to form the Rio Grande Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization (RGVMPO); and

**WHEREAS**, the RGVMPO is the current designated agency for Transportation Planning in the Transportation Management Area and the responsible agency for approving changes and selecting projects that receive TASA funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brownsville, in coordination with the RGVMPO and TxDOT Pharr District, requests an Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) amendment to reflect changes to the project; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the RGVMPO Transportation Policy Board agreed by majority vote to approve the Amendments to the Brownsville to Los Fresnos Connect Phase I & II (CSJ 0921-06-322 & 0921-06-324) project.


